


SECTION 2. COUNTY ANALYSIS

A. PORTAGE COUNTY

Portage County is comprised of 20,819 older adult aged 65 and over, accounting for 12.9% of its total population of 161,419.

Females are counted for 55.0% of total older adults aged 65 and over in Portage County, slightly lower than PSA 10B and Ohio's 57.7%.

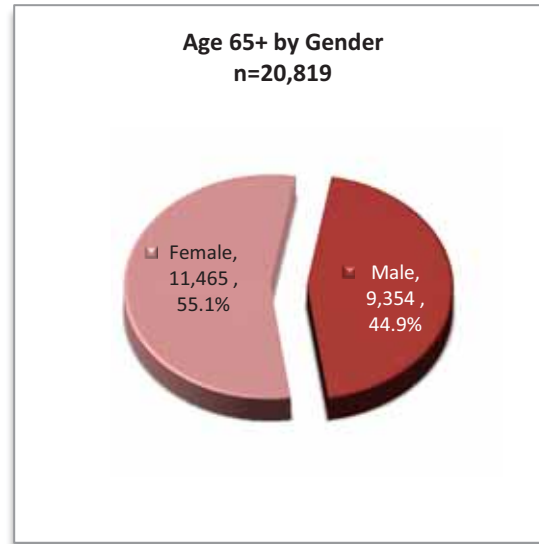
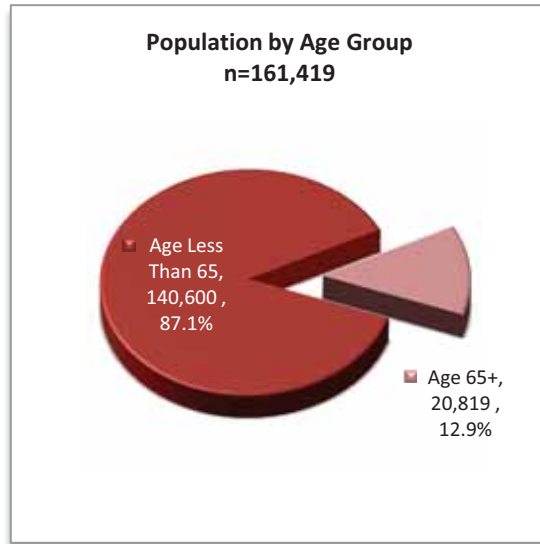

At the county subdivision level, Kent City has the largest population aged 65 and over [2,143 in total], followed by Streetsboro City with 1,880.

Mogadore Village shows the highest proportion of 65+ older adults [20.5%] with respect to their population segment.

Male population age 65 and over is estimated at 9,354 in Portage County, while female population is slightly higher at 11,465, counting for 55.0% of total population age 65 and over.

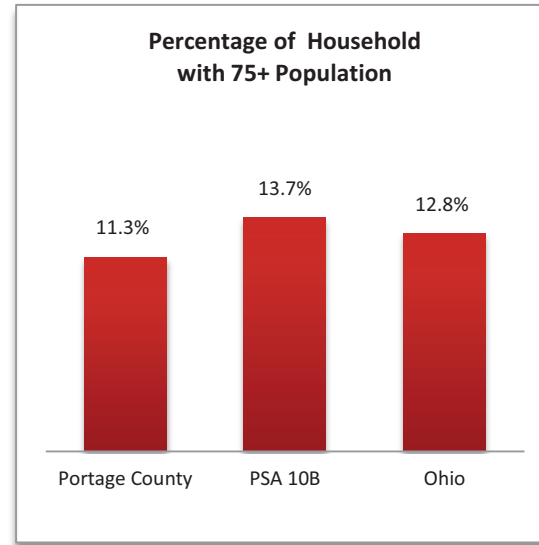

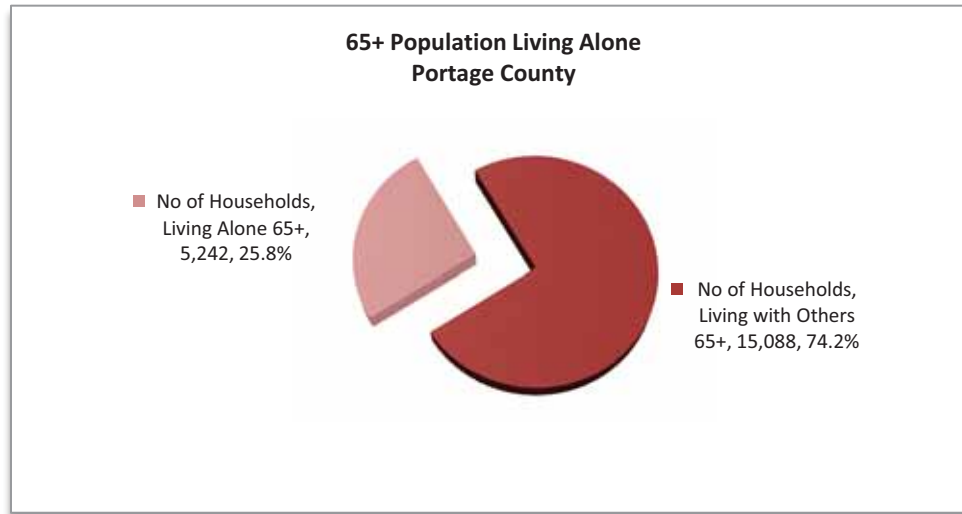

The proportion of county residents 65 years and over living alone has been remained relatively consistent from the 2000 average of 25.1% to the 2010 average of 25.8%. Top five [5] political subdivisions in Portage County whose 65+ populations well exceed 30% of their respective total 65+ populations include: Ravenna city [40.5%], Mantua village [39.6%], Kent city [39.3%], Garrettsville village [34.2%], and Brady Lake village [31.7%].

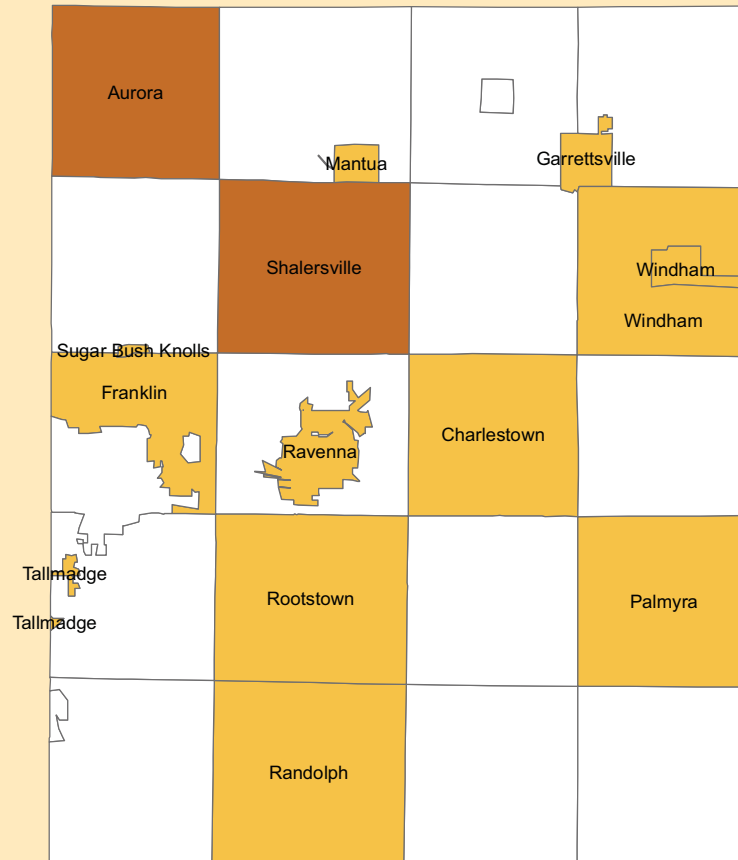

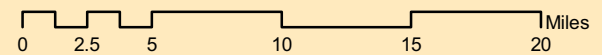
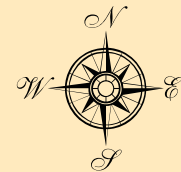

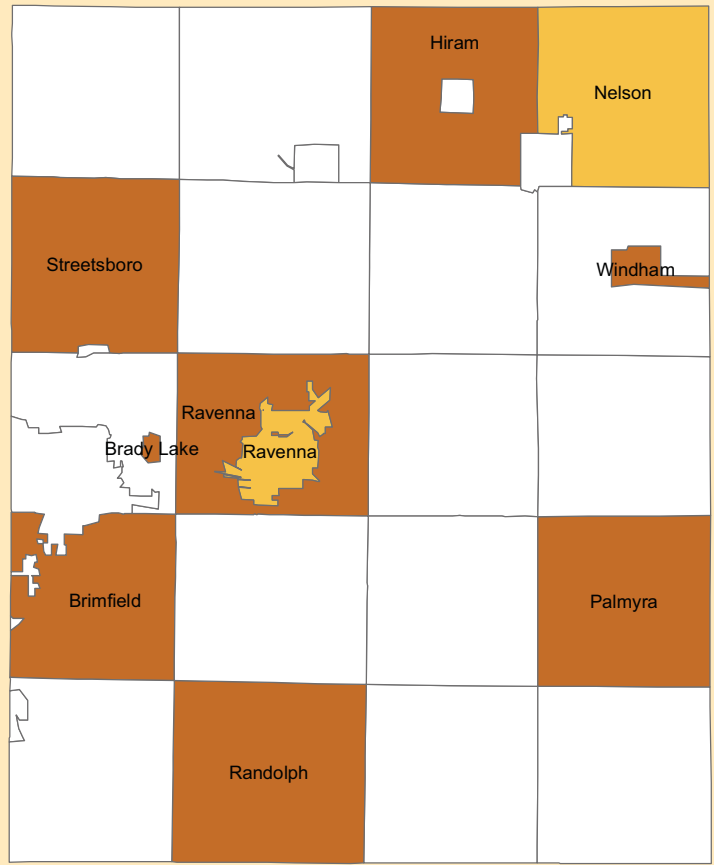

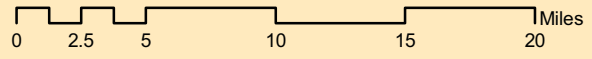

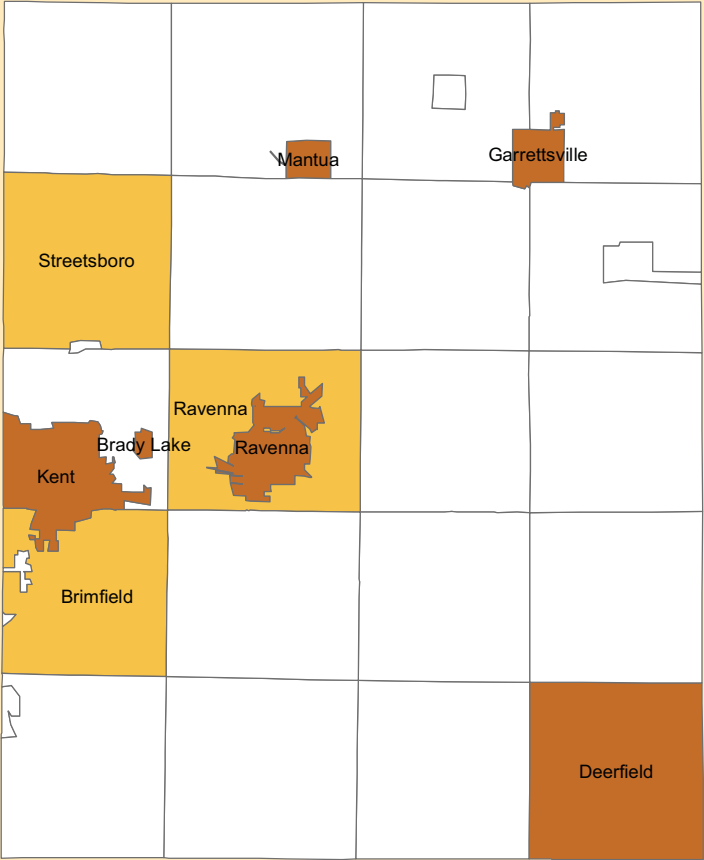

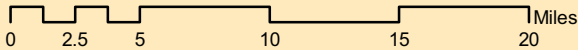
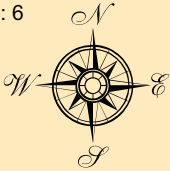

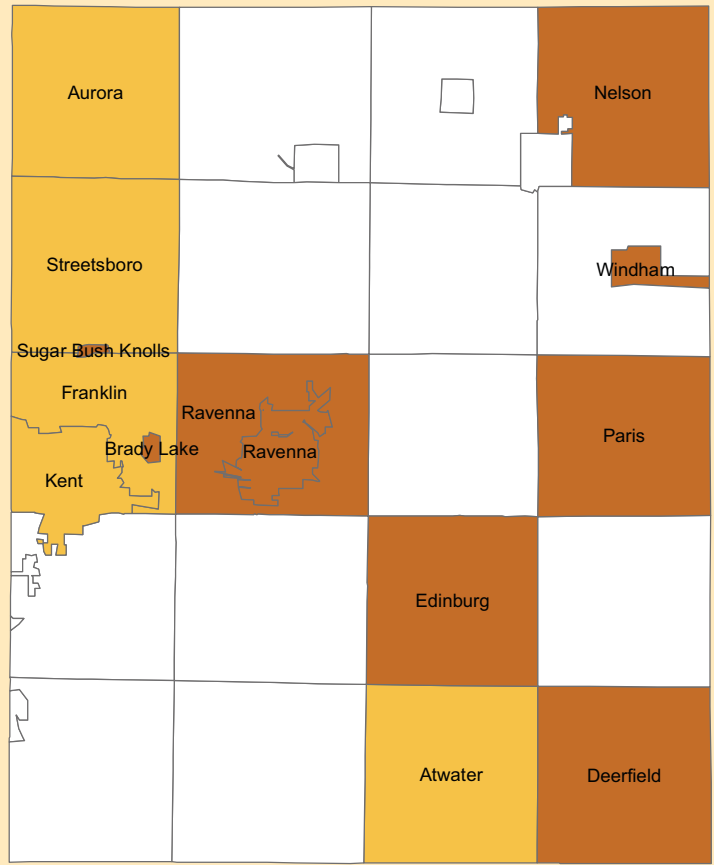

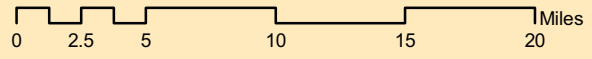
