

## D. WAYNE COUNTY

Wayne County is comprised of 16,687 older adult aged 65 and over, accounting for 14.6% of its total population of 114,520.

Females are counted for 56.2% of total older adults aged 65 and over in Wayne County, slightly lower than PSA 10B and Ohio's 57.7%.

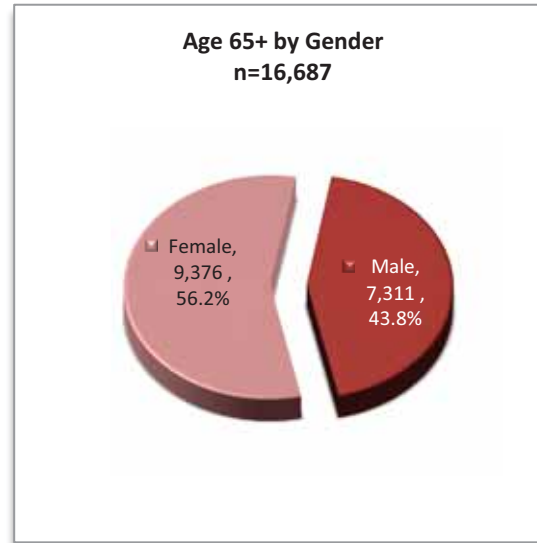
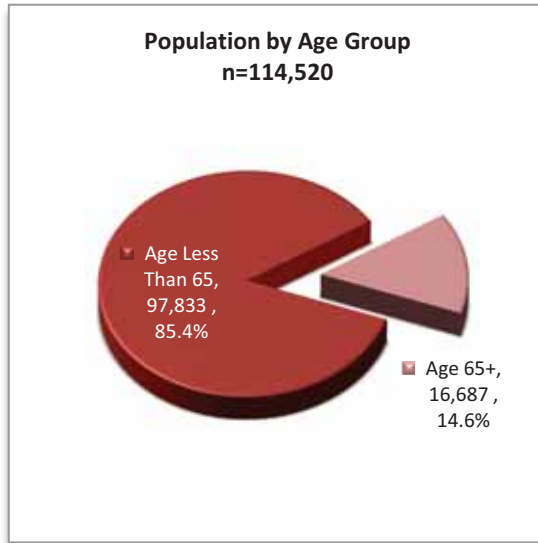

### Age 65+ Population count by County Subdivision

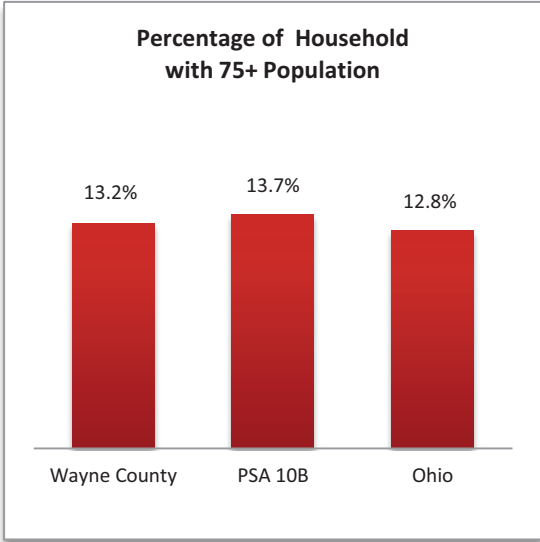
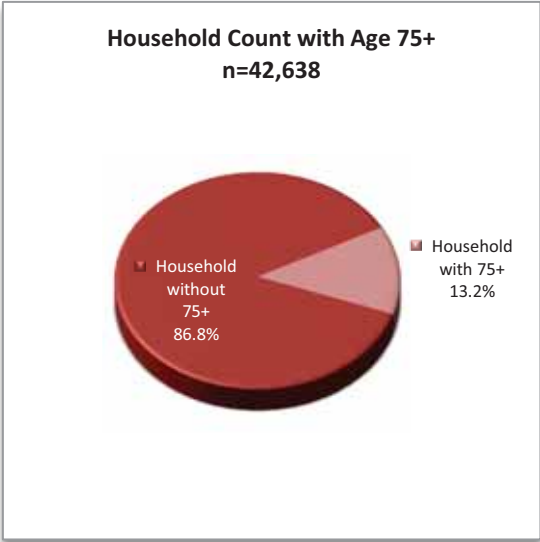

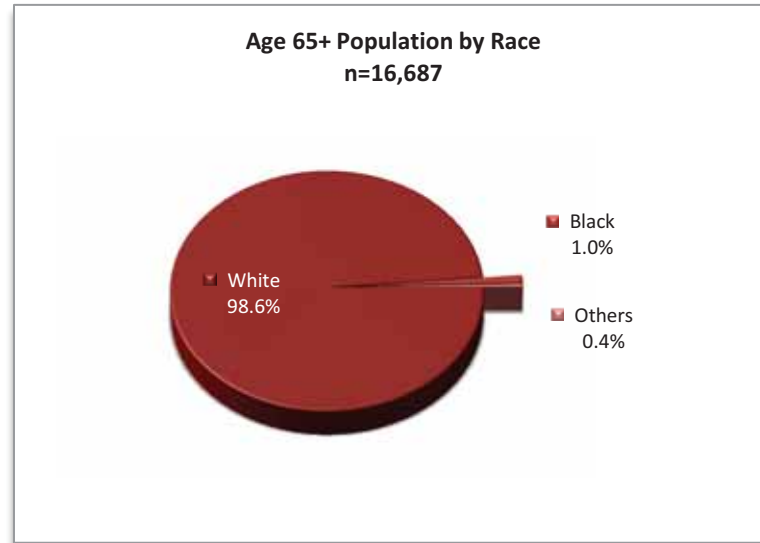

### Age 65+ Population Count by Race and County Subdivision

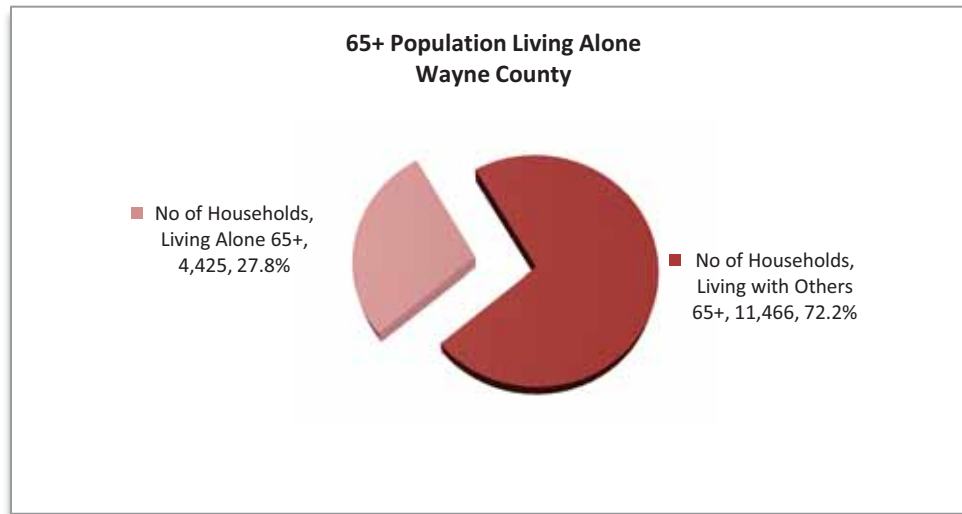

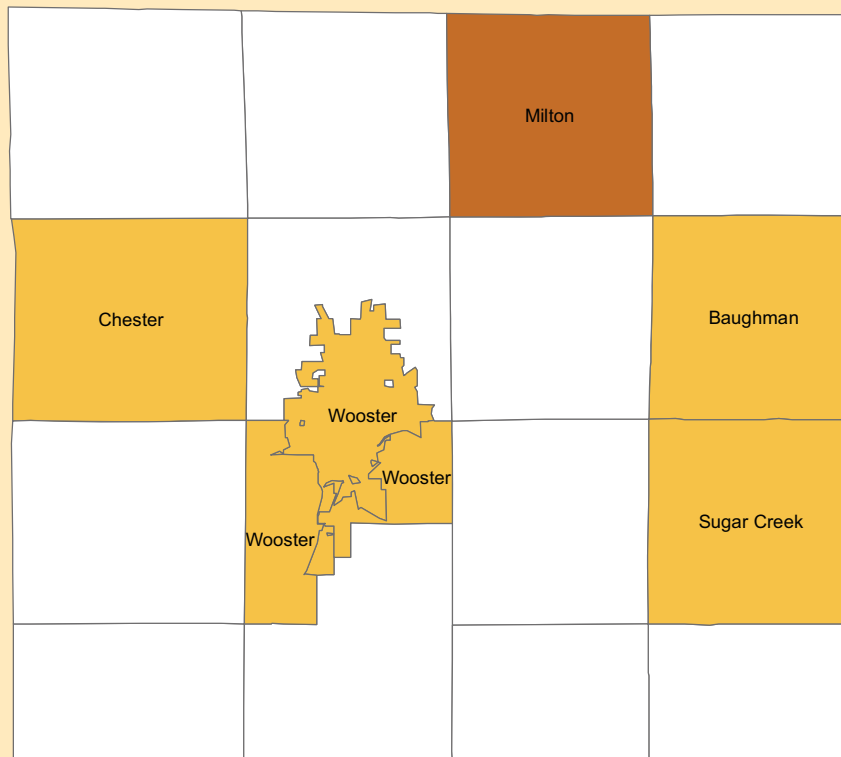

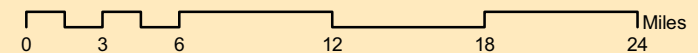
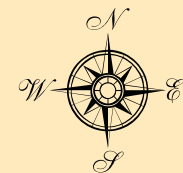

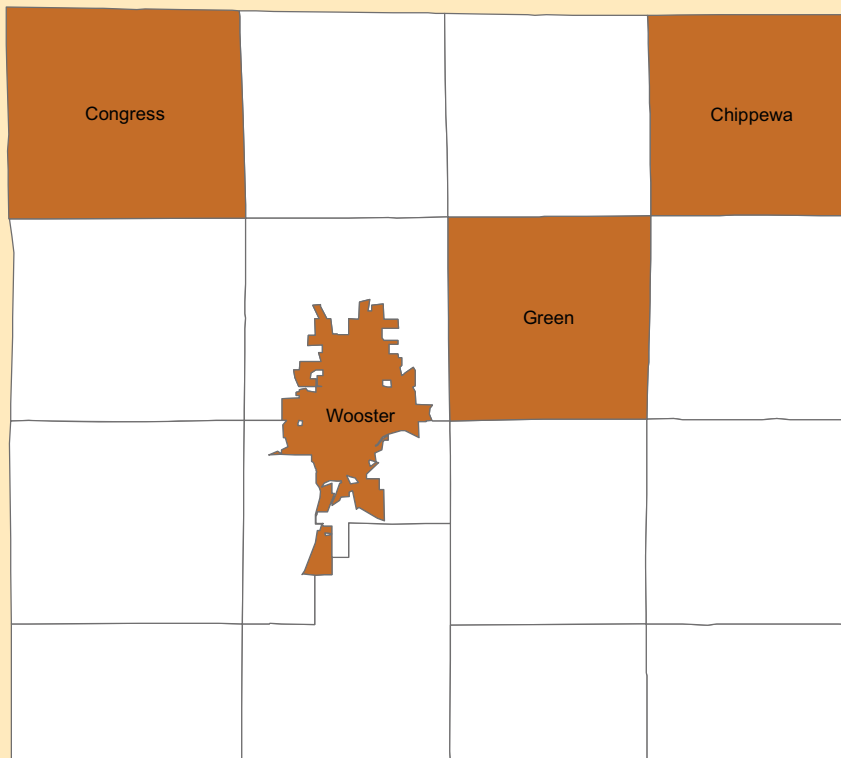

in Wayne County by County Subdivision**

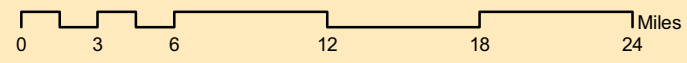
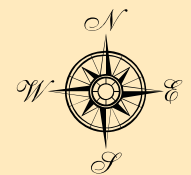

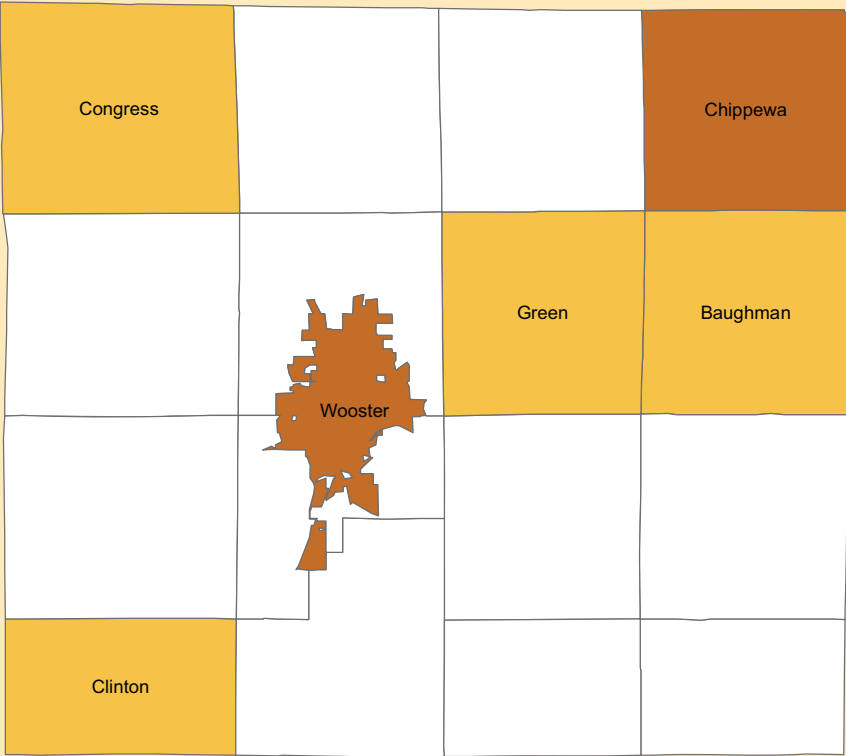

**Map 5D. Percent of the Population 65 Years and Over Living Alone in Wayne County by County Subdivision**

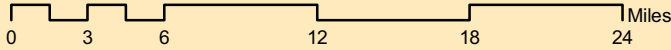
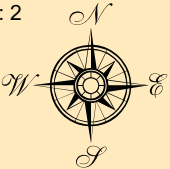

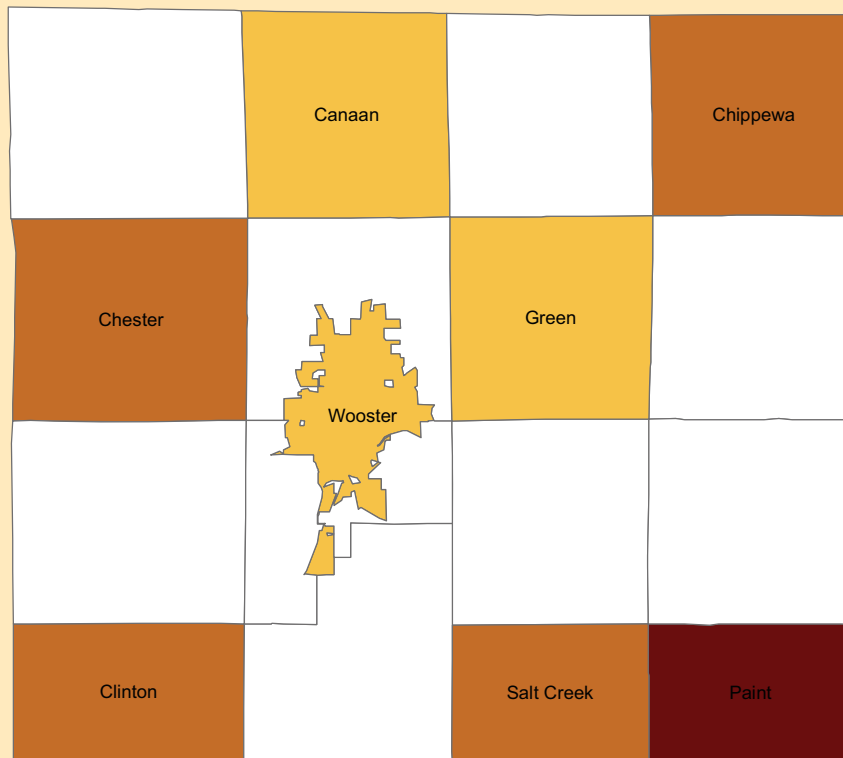

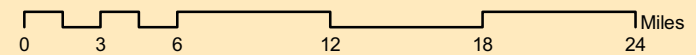
