Insurance coverage (health)	The Ohio Department of Insurance has requested that certain insurance companies ensure that members have access to needed healthcare services to test for and treat COVID-19. Lost insurance coverage	Those who do lose insurance coverage, are eligible for a special enrollment period to gain new coverage. Auto Insurance and Expired Driver Licenses	Some insured Ohioans will be unable to timely renew their driver licenses.
