What is the screening and assessment?

First, we speak with you over the phone to determine what your current needs may be. Then, we assist you in identifying long-term care options. Next, if desired, we can arrange a free in-person^{*} assessment with one of our Registered Nurses (RNs) so that the ADRC can help you apply or sign up for Agency and community programs.

Who can call?

Anyone, at any age, can call the ADRC for long-term care planning and information. We can also accept referrals for others, provide caregiver assistance, and more.

What does it cost? Do I need to sign up for anything?

Telephonic and in-person^{*} assessments to identify long-term care needs are completely *FREE*. Our ADRC representatives are happy to walk you through your options, and then next steps are completely up to you!

What other services are available through the ADRC?

Aside from program screening/eligibility and home and community-based services, the ADRC can help you or a loved one access education opportunities for lifelong learning, inclusive arts experiences, extra help with Medicare savings and Medicare education, family caregiver support, health and wellness classes, and so much more.
