Portage County Health District holds COVID-19 and Flu Shot Clinics

Portage County Health District (PCHD) will be providing COVID-19 and Seasonal Flu vaccine clinics in October and November. PCHD will be providing the 2021/2022 seasonal flu vaccine and the COVID-19 vaccines: Moderna and Pfizer. Johnson & Johnson vaccine will be available soon.

COVID-19 Vaccine Information:

PCHD has both COVID-19 vaccines available for 1st and 2nd doses (2nd dose must be the same as first dose- Moderna or Pfizer).

All COVID-19 vaccine are provided at no-cost. No health insurance information will be collected.

Pfizer Booster COVID-19 Vaccine Information:

As a vaccine provider of the state of Ohio, PCHD will provide booster doses for individuals who received Pfizer vaccine as their 1st and 2nd dose.

A single booster dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine has been authorized for limited populations who are at highest risk for COVID-19 based on their age or certain underlying medical conditions, and for those in high-risk occupational and institutional settings. The booster dose will help maximize ongoing protection against COVID-19. **A booster dose can be given at least six months following completion of the primary Pfizer series. A Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine Card must be provided.**

- People 65 years and older and residents in long-term care settings should receive a booster shot.
- People ages 50 to 64 with certain underlying medical conditions should receive a booster shot.
- People ages 18 to 49 who are at high risk for severe COVID-19 due to certain underlying medical conditions may receive a booster vaccine based on their individual benefits and risks.
- People ages 18-64 who are at increased risk for COVID-19 exposure and transmission because of occupational or institutional setting may receive a booster vaccine based on their individual benefits and risks.

People in the recommended groups based on risk who received the Moderna or Johnson & Johnson vaccine may need a booster vaccine in the future, and more data on the effectiveness and safety of these booster vaccines are expected in the coming weeks. The FDA and CDC will review that data and make recommendations accordingly.

Flu Vaccine Information:

PCHD will be providing the quadrivalent flu vaccine this 2021-2022 flu season. This flu vaccine contains 2 influenza A viruses (H1N1/H3N2) and 2 influenza B viruses. This will provide additional protection against the seasonal flu this year.

Vaccination is the best way to prevent the flu! Who should be vaccinated?

- Everyone 6 months and older (Recommendation from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention)
- Especially:
 - Pregnant Women
 - People with chronic medical conditions; including asthma and diabetes
 - Children younger than 5 years of age

Flu vaccine will be provided with a cost. Health insurance information will be collected at the time of flu vaccine administration.

- The following insurance plans are accepted and will be billed for flu vaccine: Medicaid, Buckeye, Care Source, United Health, Molina, Medicare Part B (if primary coverage), Medical Mutual-PPO, Aetna, Cigna-PPO, SummaCare-PPO, Anthem Blue Cross Blue Shield, and Paramount. No out-of-pocket costs with these plans.
 - For other insurance plans (Apex, Humana, etc.), cash or check will be accepted, and a receipt of payment will be provided to be submitted to your insurance company for possible reimbursement.
- Please bring your insurance card.
- Cost:
 - \$30 for children and adults.
 - \$70 for High Dose (recommended for 65 years and older)
- If uninsured or underinsured, flu shots will be \$10.
- Pneumonia shots will also be available for individuals 65 years and older and high-risk individuals. Same insurances are accepted with no out-of-pocket cost.
 - Prevnar 13-cost \$260
 - Pneumovax 23-cost \$130
