Make Choices Have Control, Flexibility & Freedom **Get Support**

Direct Your Own Care

VDC is designed to provide you with more choice and control in directing your services and care. In the VDC program, you decide what, when, where, and how services, supports, and goods are provided to you, and from **whom**.

A Care Manager from Direction Home will work alongside eligible veterans to assess needs that enable independence. They will work with the veteran to create a spending plan, and continuously evaluate its progress over time.

The veteran will make choices about services and supports and hire professionals to provide them. Veterans receive support from the care manager and money from the created spending plan.
